TENDER NOTICE

The Forest Directorate, Govt. of West Bengal, has decided to recruit 771 (seven hundred seventy one) Nos. Forest Guards to fill up the vacant posts in the districts of Darjeeling, Jalpaiguri, Cooch Behar, Birbhum, Burdwan, Bankura, Paschim Medinipur, Purulia, Purba Medinipur, Nadia, Murshidabad and 24-Parganas (S). The Forest Guards so recruited will be posted in the forest area of the aforesaid districts. The candidates will have to appear in a written competitive examination followed by interview and fulfill other eligibility criteria viz., completion of 25 km.walking test in 4 hrs. for male candidate and 14 km in 4 hrs for female candidates and have the physical standards (For Men : Height - 163 cm, Chest girth - 84 cm (expansion 5 cm) and For Women : Height - 150 cm, Chest girth - 79 cm (expansion 5 cm) . These requirements are relaxable in case of hill men in the district of Darjeeling and S.T. candidates also for whom the minimum requirement of height shall be 152.5 cm for men and 145 cm for women. The chest measurement are relaxable by 5 cm for both men and women. The candidates will also be examined for physical fitness by the Medical Board to be constituted as per rule.

The Directorate of Forests, therefore, intends to select a recruitment consultant and invites sealed tenders from eligible and bonafide organizations / institutes for necessary assistance in the matter of recruitment of Forest Guards in the manner and to the extent as detailed in the tender document. The detailed tender document may be procured @ Rs.2,000/- (Rupees two thousand) only from the office of the PCCF (HoFF), W.B., Aranya Bhawan LA-10A Block, Sector-III, Saltlake City, Kolkata - 98, from 16th March, 2011 to 30th March, 2011 (up to 14 hrs.). The last date of submission of tender is 08.04.11 (up to 12 hrs). The tender document will also be available on our website www.westbengalforest.gov.in and www.sunderbanbiospherereserve.org. during the period stated above.
